If you have purchased a license to the [Linear Bar Code Module](#) or the [2D Bar Code Module](#), for DesignMerge software, you must install the provided set of bar code fonts.

Starting with **DesignMerge for Adobe InDesign 2022**, we have implemented a brand new method for producing linear bar codes. LINEAR AND 2D BAR CODE FONTS

The DesignMerge Linear Bar Code Module and 2D Bar Code Module include barcode fonts and other components licensed from IDAutomation.com, Inc. These fonts may only be used with DesignMerge software or with other OEM versions of DesignMerge software, including but not limited to **EngageIT VDP** and **AccurioPro VDP** software. The fonts include special encodings that are compatible only with DesignMerge software, and as such they are not compatible with and should not be used in conjunction with any other applications.

All fonts have been provided in *Open Type* format only, and are **compatible with both Macintosh and Widows systems**. Please install all of the fonts into your system before working with DesignMerge software to create variable bar codes.
